

"International social work of all people in the whole world: a new construction 2nd edition"



JUNPO-Sha released "International Social Work of all people in the Whole World: a new construction 2nd Edition" in English on October 31, 2024. The initial segment features an updated version of Honorary Director Dr. Akimoto's January monograph. For the second segment, ARIISW enlisted with contributions from external authors, Mr. Hiromi Satoh (Reitaku University), Dr. Taichi Uchio (Shizuoka University of Art and Culture), Dr. Ayako Sasaki (Chiba University), Dr. Takeshi Sato-Daimon (Waseda University), Dr. Masateru Higashida (ARIISW Program Researcher), and Dr. Josef Gohori (Shukutoku University).

The publication aims to firmly support the development of a novel International Social Work theory envisioned by Dr. Akimoto. It offers a groundbreaking perspective on the global accumulation of international social work knowledge. Through JUNPO's collaboration, the English version is accessible worldwide via Amazon.jp. A Japanese edition is slated for release in the coming February.
